5. Shinsa categories: Kyōshi, Hachidan, Nanadan, Rokudan
6. Eligibility: Kyōshi: Applicants who have obtained Renshi by the 6th May 2016 and Rokudan by the 4th May 2017.  
Hachidan: Applicants who have obtained Nanadan by the 6th May 2017.  
Nanadan: Applicants who have obtained Rokudan by the 5th May 2017.  
Rokudan: Applicants who have obtained Godan by the 5th May 2017.
7. Deadline: Monday, 5th March 2017  
The deadline will be strictly enforced.
8. Other:
  - 1) Please read the "Taking the Chuo Shinsa" file available on IKYF's website.
  - 2) Applicants who have already passed the Hachidan 1st Shinsa since 2017 Regular Chuo Shinsa (Kyoto) will be exempt from the first round examination.  
Please write the date of passing the 1st Shinsa in red ink on the applicant's remarks column, in the bottom right corner of the application form.
  - 3) Applicant's shinsa category, shinsa number, country and name will be put on the program of the 69th All Japan Kyudo Taikai.
